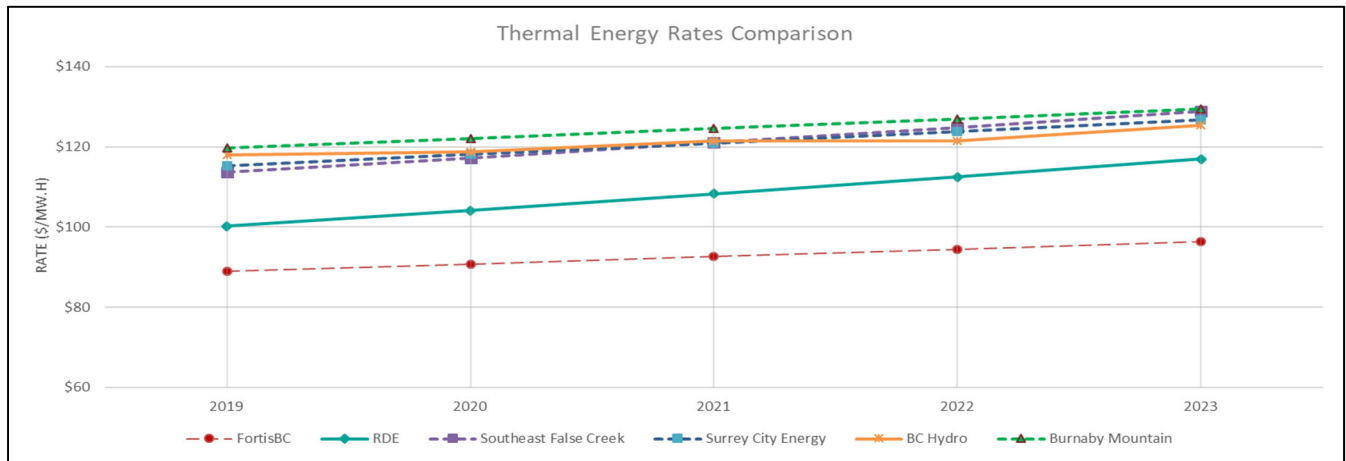
TO: ALL OWNERS / RESIDENTS

RE: 2019-2023 RATES APPLICATION

Following three years of unchanged energy rates, River District Energy (RDE) will be making an application to the BC Utilities Commission this June, for 3.94% non-retroactive annual rate increases as summarized in the following table:

Monthly Capacity Charge (\$/m ²)	0.55	0.57	0.59	0.62	0.64	0.67
Thermal Energy Charge (\$/MW.h)	35.84	37.24	38.69	40.2	41.77	43.4

The average cost change to a 650 ft² home in the River District is approximately \$2 per month per year. We are confident RDE rates will remain highly competitive amongst similar thermal energy services, a comparative illustration of our proposed rates is offered below:
